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matters to God. Our deepest hunger or thirst and source of true happiness is to seek the love of God above all else. May we purify our hearts from bad instincts and sinfulness and seek to possess God alone, the source of infinite goodness, love and mercy. May we redouble our efforts to practice the spiritual and corporal works of mercy and appropriately live a Christian life which depicts the countenance of our Lord and portray His charity.

St. Faustina Kowalska, the "Apostle of Divine Mercy" expressed the depth of the mystery of the Holy Eucharist as a mystery of mercy. In her diary she stated, "Who will ever conceive and understand the depth of mercy that has gushed forth from Your Heart? A great mystery is accomplished in the Holy Mass. O Jesus, my Jesus, with what great pain is my soul pierced when I see the fountain of life gushing forth with such sweetness and power for each soul, while at the same time I see souls withering away and drying up through their own fault. O Jesus, grant that the power of mercy embrace these souls (914). Jesus, there is one more secret in my life, the deepest and dearest to my heart: it is You Yourself when You come to my heart under the appearance of bread. Herein lies the whole secret of my sanctity. Here my heart is so united with Yours as to be but one. There are no more secrets, because all that is Yours is mine, and all that is mine is Yours. Such is the omnipotence and the miracle of Your mercy. All the tongues of men and of angels united could not find words adequate to this mystery of Your love and mercy (1489).

Repeatedly throughout her young life, the Polish nun was constantly awed by the mystery of God's mercy in the Holy Eucharist. No wonder; her full name as a religious sister—St. Maria Faustina of the Most Blessed Sacrament. The Holy Eucharist was the center and key to her life. May we try to emulate her example of devotion as adorers of our Lord Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament and pray, "O Blessed Host, have mercy on us. Amen".

Reflection

Lord Jesus, tonight, we heard St. John's story telling us that after You fed the five thousand, they went searching energetically for You. They borrowed some boats and rowed right across the lake in search of You. At last they found You and they were happy.

Jesus, you begin by telling them that they are coming in search of You, not because of the 'signs' that You are doing, but because of the bread that they were given to eat. They have missed seeing the point of what You were doing - bringing love to a hungry world. Lord, they have seen the things that You did but missed the 'sign', - the deeper meaning behind the fish and bread they ate - that You are the Bread of Life that came down from heaven. The food they are looking for is not the food that counts. The real food they need is the one that brings life eternal - the food that You offer. It parallels with

the water "springing up to eternal life" which You promised the Samaritan woman (John 4:14).

Many of us like the five thousand are blinded to see Your signs. We are deaf to hear Your words "Come to me all you who are weary and are burdened and I will give you rest" Matthew 11:28. We fail to say, "Here I am, Lord I come to seek your presence. I long for your healing love."
