The centurion said in reply, Lord, I am not worthy to have you enter under my roof; only say the word and my servant will be healed - Matthew 8:8". These words of the centurion come from his heart. They were words of sincerity expressing great faith in what lesus can do for his servant. He said them boldly with humility knowing his strength as well as his weaknesses. Conscious of his unworthiness in the presence of God, the centurion believed without a doubt that Jesus words has power even without his presence. What is marvelous with this centurion is his expression of his great faith for the healing of his servant. It invites me to imagine the kind of faith he would express if the person he wants Jesus to heal is his child or wife who is more precious and dear to him? Perhaps he is a man who sees God in everyone worthy of his love as Jesus loved us. Are you moved by the centurion's faith and love? Do you feel being invited to take a long good look at yourselves to get a clearer sense if vou are worthy to have Jesus live in vou? Are you made to feel to see your thoughts and actions that distanced you from Jesus and how they have hurt other people around you? Are words of the centurion piercing your heart
