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## THE MAGNIFICAT

Mary said: My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord, my spirit rejoices in God my Savior.

The Lord has exalted me by a gift so great, so unheard of, that language is useless to describe it, and the depths of love in my heart can scarcely grasp it. I offer then all the powers of my soul in praise and thanksgiving. As I contemplate his greatness, which knows no limits, I joyfully surrender my whole life, my senses, my judgment, for my spirit rejoices in the eternal Godhead of that Jesus, that Savior, whom I have conceived in this world of time.

The Almighty has done great things for me, and holy is his name.

Mary looks back to the beginning of her song, where she said: My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord. Only that soul for whom the Lord in his love does great things can proclaim his greatness with fitting praise and encourage those who share her desire and purpose, saying: Join with me in proclaiming the greatness of the Lord; let us extol his name together.

Those who know the Lord, yet refuse to proclaim his greatness and sanctify his name to the limit of their power, will be called least in the kingdom of heaven. His name is called holy because in the sublimity of his unique power he surpasses every creature and is far removed from all that he had made.

He has come to the help of his servant Israel for he has remembered his promise of mercy.

In a beautiful phrase Mary calls Israel the servant of the Lord. The Lord came to his aid to save him. Israel is an obedient and humble servant, in the words of Hosea: Israel was a servant, and I loved him.

Those who refuse to be humble cannot be saved. They cannot say with the prophet: See, God comes to my aid; the Lord is the helper of my soul. But anyone who makes himself humble like a little child is greater in the kingdom of heaven.

The promise he made to our fathers, to Abraham and his children for ever.

This does not refer to the physical descendants of Abraham, but to his spiritual children. These are his descendants, sprung not from the flesh only, but who, whether circumcised or not, have followed him in faith. Circumcised as he was, Abraham believed, and this was credited to him as an act of righteousness.

The coming of the Savior was promised to Abraham and to his descendants for ever. These are the children of promise, to whom it is said: If you belong to Christ, then you are descendants of Abraham, heirs in accordance with the promise.

## I WILL GIVE YOU REST

In the words of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, true blessedness is, "hearing God's Word and keeping it". What a great blessing it is to hear His Word and to practice! Isn't it the very heart of true discipleship?

Blessed Mother Mary is the first and perfect disciple of our Lord. Our Lady's "Fiat" at the Annunciation revealed her blessedness in wisdom, strength, faith and trust in God's Word. Her entire life is pervaded by the certainty that God is near and showers her with His providential care. In her Magnificat she said, "All generation shall call me Blessed, The Mighty One has done great things for me, Holy is His name".

The keeping of the Word of God

is both in full harmony with the Father's proclamation at Transfiguration, "This is my Beloved Son, listen to Him and the Blessed Mother's advice to the guests at Cana, "Do whatever He tells you". Both the Heavenly Father and the earthly Mother point to the Incarnate Word and command us to obey Him.

The first effect of the advent of God's word is to fill us with a vision of His own Heart. By inviting us to come to Him, Jesus is introducing us to a relationship with the Father. He never ceases to be an obedient, loving, faithful Son. No one knows the Son except the Father and no one knows the Father except the Son. The loving bond of the Father and the Son is the Holy Spirit who has the power to transform and recreate our hearts to become God's children. Only as disciples can we hope to become adopted sons and daughters of the Father. This requires total dependence and childlike submission to His Holy Will.

"Jesus gives us rest". This rest is neither laziness nor a restoration of energy. It is a way of life rooted in our relationship to "God as Father of All Humanity". Such rest is utter trust actually lived out moment by moment. It means to allow the Father full room as our Creator so we can become a "wet clay in His hands" impressing upon us any form He chooses. Ultimately, the call to discipleship is above all our response to an invitation, to an intimate companionship with Jesus, taking up His offer to share in His yoke, which is easy and the burden light. It is a life centered on prayer, adoration and worship. As we share our lives with the Lord step by step, little by little we are transformed to a new life, a new creation. Like St. Paul, we can say, "it is no longer I that lives but Christ lives in me".

## CELEBRATING ...

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the Rosary is one of the most beneficial ways of praying – for it unites both vocal and mental prayer. For each mystery we recite,



we contemplate on the life of Jesus and Mary. It excites in us a deep love and reverence for God. This relationship with God sustains us in body, mind and spirit as we do the works entrusted to us in this community.

Mankind today needs God's goodness, love and mercy more than ever. We share in this in consecration to Jesus' and Mary's hearts and in living out this consecration. Before the Sacrament of Love, we adore Jesus with profound reverence and penitent heart. We acknowledge and receive His invitation to rest in His love and claim His healing graces. We partake of His Body and Blood to share in the divine life of the Blessed Trinity. Together with Him is the Blessed Virgin Mary - the Mother of God and Mother of the Church. She is our loving and powerful intercessor and spiritual mother of the human race. By the merits of her virtues and powerful intercession we are drawn closer to God through Jesus with the help of the Holy Spirit.
