**T**ruly the mercy of God is everlasting and His benefits are generous! We praise and thank our Lord Jesus for He listened to the cries of our hearts yearning for justice, mercy and compassion. Though we were drowned in melancholy and bitterness for the closing of St. Bridget Church but Jesus remained in us all the way along a perplexing and turbulent journey of finding a new venue. With the grace of the Advocate, the Holy Spirit who dwells in our souls we were strengthened to persevere in prayer and hope for God's will to reign in our discernment process. True, we lost St. Bridget Church as our house of worship, but in God's great benevolence He provided St. Anthony of Padua Catholic Church as the new venue for Healing Prayer Service/ Eucharistic Adoration, and St. Mary of the Immaculate Conception Parish for 2000 Hail Mary's Devotion.



Anthony of Padua Roman Catholic Church, with its impressive Gothic Architecture and intricate arrays of amazingly beautiful stained glass windows enshrines the Miraculous Cross, Our Lady of Czestochowa and Saint John Paul II. In 1895, the original Saint Anthony's Church was completely destroyed by a massive fire. What awesome wonder that only a large crucifix above the main altar

miraculously survived, untouched by the fire. For many years this crucifix was displayed in the foyer of the church. However, along with many repairs and improvements to one of Jersey City's most beautiful churches, Father Joseph Urban has refurbished a side chapel where parishioners can once again be able to pray before Christianity's greatest symbol of God's mercy.

On February 23, 2015, the Eucharistic Love Community commenced its services in St. Anthony of Padua.

Since it is the season of Lent, the Eucharistic adorers prayed the Stations of the Cross and Eucharistic Adoration followed. The 2000 Hail Mary's Devotion began on February 28, 2015 in the house of Mary; which is the St. Mary of the Immaculate Conception Parish.
